## SOLOIST BIOS

**Larry Zheng**, aged 17, started learning his violin and viola at the age of 5 and 9. He obtained his ARSM viola examination with Merit in 2019 and also passed ATCL violin performance in 2022. Larry was also a violinist of Hong Kong Junior Chamber Ensemble in 2018. He was awarded the Bronze Prize in the Viola Junior group in Hong Kong Bauhinia Cup String Competition 2017. Larry enjoys playing chamber music. He has been performing in the Young Musicians Series since 2015. In 2019 he attended a Master class for young musicians in New York and performed a concert at Carnegie Hall. Larry also performed with the Uof T Scarborough String Orchestra for two years. Currently Larry is the principal violist of the CSYO and a member of the Toronto Symphony Youth Orchestra.

**Jeremy Lin** is a 17 year old trombonist and pianist. Jeremy began piano at the age of 4, building the musical foundation that later shaped his approach to trombone. In 2022, he won three first-place awards in piano at the North York Music Festival and was invited to perform at the yearly gala. Jeremy has achieved RCM Level 9 piano performance with distinction and honors, currently pursuing Level 10. Jeremy has performed with the Toronto Youth Wind Orchestra Symphonic Winds as a bass trombonist and is principal trombonist in a variety of musical ensembles including Jazz band, Symphonic Band, and Symphony Orchestra at Earl Haig Secondary School. He has also received both the Impressive Progress Award and the Dedication Award from his school's music department in recognition of his commitment and growth. Outside of rehearsals, he continues to develop his musicianship through solo practice, ensemble playing, and exploring a wide range of repertoire.

**Ji Ya "Kali" Huang** (17 years old) has been playing the trombone for four years and studies with freelancer Aaron Chan (bass trombonist). He is an active member of the music department at Bayview Secondary School through regular participation in the Senior Wind Ensemble and Jazz Band. He currently conducts the Brass Ensemble and will continue to do so in his senior year. This year, he primarily manages performances and events and will serve as one of five executive members on his school's music council for the upcoming school year. Kali has won multiple school awards such as the Instrumental Music award and Certificate of Merits. This year, he earned a scholarship of half bursary to the Interprovincial Music Camp that was given to only one person from his school's ensemble during their time at the Ontario Band Association's Provincial Band Festival. On top of that, he is a part of extracurricular ensembles such as the Toronto Youth Wind Orchestra Symphonic Winds and more.

**Miles Nghiem** began his cello studies at the age of five with Susan Gagnon. He currently studies at the Phil and Eli Taylor Performance Academy for Young Artists at the Royal Conservatory of Music, where he continues to refine his artistry and passion for performance. Miles has been recognized for his artistic conviction and expressive playing, earning numerous awards including Royal Conservatory of Music Regional Gold Medals, the Ann Southam Award, and the National Mary Gardiner Award for Performance Excellence at the Toronto Contemporary Showcase. He has also achieved First Place at the Toronto Kiwanis Music Festival, the Star MVP Music Festival, and the OMFA Provincial Finals, as well as Second Place at the Canadian Music Competition National Finals. Beyond music, Miles enjoys traveling, exploring new cultures, and studying new languages. He is currently a Grade 6 student at the Lycée Français de Toronto.
